


Here are two useful examples. Memorize arpeggios: let's say there's a song that uses a few arpeggios you want to memorize. The idea is that, the fewer the notes in the background, the more creative room the lead instrumentalist has to express their interpretation of the piece. Another is if you're using percussive strumming rhythms (hear example) or picked rolls and you want a tighter sound. Here I alternate between power chord extensions... Here I alternate between suspended 4th and major shell forms... String names aren't noted on the templates just in case you want to write parts that use alternate tunings. For example, here's how you would write down the first part of the classic guitar riff from the song Smoke on the Water using these templates: Check out how the above example compares with the actual Guitar TAB in this guide on 14 Easy Guitar Riffs to Learn. As demonstrated in the video, we can add a 9th or major 7th to the basic root-5th power chord shape for some distortion-friendly colour... In jazz, the rhythm part will typically involve comping using shell chords to allow the soloist the freedom to build a number of different harmonies and melodies. I've marked the slides in blue (/ = up slide \ = down slide)... However, it is better to use the b5 and #5 extensions as shown in the shapes below. If a string is played open, write a big O above the string line. In this lesson we'll explore some cut down chord shapes, often called shell chords or closed harmony, that allow for quicker, more tightly voiced chord playing. These fretboard templates show 12 frets - remember that the notes repeat at the 12th fret, so you can use these templates for below or above the 12th fret. Blank Guitar Fretboard PDFs These blank guitar fretboard diagrams are handy if you want to memorize scales or work on arpeggios. The lines print as light grey, which makes it easier for you to read any pencil or pen you write. Check out this guide on How to Read Guitar TAB for a list of common symbols you might want to use. Don't worry if you don't know how to write in rhythm notation, you can write down any notes or comments to help you as you like. If you're a beginner and want to get started learning guitar chords, check out these 10 Easy Guitar Chords to Learn First. It's about cutting down the chord as far as possible whilst retaining its recognisable quality (major, minor, diminished, dominant 7th etc.) There are several uses for shell chords, from simply economising one's fingering to creating a "tighter" sound. Blank Guitar TAB PDFs These blank Guitar TAB PDFs give you a simple way to quickly write down any guitar riff or lick ideas you come up with, or any songs you're learning to transcribe. Please note that the b5 and the #11 are the same notes, they are enharmonic like the #5 and the b13 that are enharmonic too, so there are two other possibilities, 7#5 and 7b13. For example, here are three different ways you can use this template to write down the basic C Major open chord: You can either write the finger numbers (1 = index finger, 2 = middle finger, 3 = ring finger, 4 = pinky) underneath each string or on the fret positions so you know which fingers to use for each note. So with major and minor triads, for example, we'd only need three strings to make the chord. An alternative to these printable templates is to use a program like Guitar Pro to create any resource you want. While you can memorize them by using Guitar TAB, sometimes it's handy to have a way to visualize the arpeggio shapes on your fretboard. Some people like to use dots on the fret positions while other people may prefer seeing the finger numbers in each position. You can use these templates for open chords or for barre chords in any tuning. With seventh chords, we might leave out the 5th so we're still only using three strings. The below image shows an arpeggio in Guitar TAB format: You can certainly memorize this arpeggio by reading the Guitar TAB or Standard Notation, but being able to visualize the shape of the arpeggio on the fretboard will help you memorize it faster. Eery... In this guide, you can download a variety of free blank Guitar TAB, chord chart, fretboard diagram, or sheet music templates. As always, let your ears be the judge. Let's start with an overview by watching the presentation below... Please note that 7#5 chords can be written 7aug or 7+5 or aug7. Notice that there are two rootless chord voicings, meaning that the root tone is not play but simply represented by a red circle. If the chord doesn't play a certain string, write an X above the string line (eg: the above example doesn't play the low E string). But generally speaking, shell chords are just simplified chords that have their own specific sound. Check out this guide on the Pentatonic Scale if you want an easy scale to memorize. And something similar using an augmented 5th... One example is if you're using a lot of gain or distortion and need more clarity and punch in your chord playing, or just some more intricate alternatives to the standard power chord forms. Try finger plucking these alternative shell forms for more understated playing... I loved this diminished 9th power chord sound. The ninth of a dominant chord can be lowered or raised by a half-step, thus giving two altered dominant chords : 7b9 and 7#9. Great for phrased picking... The below example shows the first 'box' shape of the Pentatonic Scale in Guitar TAB format: While this is easy enough to understand and use to memorize the scale shape, here's the same shape on the fretboard diagram: Seeing the scale shapes on a fretboard diagram makes it much easier to work on finger positions. Starting with a simple exercise moving between E and A string shell forms (click the tab to hear)... Here are eight guitar diagrams to play altered dominant chords. So let's start with the fifth of V7, that can be altered with a sharp (#) or a flat (b). It means that the altered notes are not specified, you can decide which alteration you add to the dominant 7 chord. All three examples above show the same information, so have a think about which way you prefer reading your chords. Was this helpful? These shell forms are great for sliding. ^ Back to Top Blank printable Guitar TAB templates are handy when you want to quickly write down any ideas or exercises you want to work on. Finally, I introduce chromatic movements to some of the shell forms we've learned. Simply put, shell chords are a form of economising whereby we use chord shapes that consist of only the most important tones of the chord. Altered dominant chords can contain one or more alterations, the choice depends on the melody. Here are some chord shapes that will help you to hear some of these altered chords. Use These Guitar TAB Templates To use these blank Guitar TAB templates, simply write down the fret numbers for any notes on the lines as needed. Memorize scale shapes: instead of memorizing scale shapes using Guitar TAB, it's much easier and faster to memorize scales using fretboard diagrams. You can use these as exercises or just inspiration for coming up with your own ideas. Once you're confident with the shapes, it's just a case of combining them through trial and error. Here I've tabbed out the examples I used in the video. Remember, these shapes are movable, so you can position them at any fret, just like barre chords. You can easily figure out which fingers you should use to play each note just by glancing at the diagram. Start here if you are a beginner. I'll show you how even the simplest chords can sound colourful. Check out my review of Guitar Pro 8 to learn more.
